

Atlantic Waste Disposal Odor Mitigation Timeline - 2015 through 2016

2015

- January 2015
 - Acquire gas rights on-site
 - o Purchase two (2) portable, waterless deodorizer system
- February 2015
 - Completion of 30-acre temporary cap design
 - Construction of additional bio-filters
- March 2015 through December 2015
 - Installation of 30-acre temporary cap
 - Expansion of gas extraction system
 - Upgraded blower and motor on temporary flare
 - Purchase 5 portable deodorizer systems
 - Odor neutralizing system expansion #3
 - Add third pump
 - Add approximately 2,000 feet of hose (133 nozzles)
 - Installation of additional flare
 - Design of additional 60+-acres temporary synthetic cap

2016

- January 2016 through November 2016
 - Install 60+-acre temporary synthetic cap (Phase I and Phase II)
 - o Install additional 30+-acre clay cap (Phase IV)
 - Gas system expansion 102 gas collection wells (total of 395 devices)
 - Installed two (2) new permanent flares




Atlantic Waste Disposal Odor Mitigation Timeline - 2017

2017

- January through December 2017
 - Install approximate 38-acre Phase IV temporary synthetic cap (top of landfill)
 - o Install approximate 30-acre Phase III temporary synthetic cap
 - o Gas system expansion 26 new gas collection wells (total of 421 devices)
 - o Install cap on other areas as needed
 - o Begin operation of on-site wastewater treatment plant
